**APPLICABILITY/ACCOUNTABILITY:**

This policy is applicable to all members of the University community, including all applicants, students, faculty and staff and all visitors, contractors and guests at the University or any of its campuses, facilities or events. This policy is intended to comply with Section 1006.68, Florida Statutes.

**POLICY STATEMENT:**

This policy establishes guidelines for the provision of instruction, information, and activities regarding human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) and acquired immune deficiency syndrome (AIDS). Students, employees, and applicants for admission or employment at the University who have or who may become infected with HIV/AIDS will not be excluded from enrollment or
