### Key Differences and PI Requirements Remase I and PhaseSBIR and STTRograms **STTR**

For both Phase I and Phase II proposals, the Princip Investigator (PI) must have primary employment with the SBC at the time of award and during the conduct of The primary employment of the Principal Investigator must be with the SBC or the research titution at the the proposed project. Primary employment means that more than onehalf of the PI's time is spent in the employ of the SBC. This precludes-finalle employment with another organization, so a ftilhe FAU faculty member cannot be the PI for an SBIR proposal.

#### Office of Technology Development (OTD)

Faculty should contact the Office of Technology Development (OTD) notisand invention disclosure form as soon as they feel they have discovered something unique with possible commercial value. This should be done well before presenting the discovery through publications, posters, conferences, or other communications. Once publicly disclosed (i.e., published or presented in some form-France), an invention may have restricted or minimal potential for intellectual property protection.

#### SBIR and STTR Program Guidance

Each agency administers its own individual program within guidelines established by Congress. These agencies designate R&D topics in their solicitations and accept proposals from small businesses. Awards are issued on a competitive basis after proposal evaluation.

ThreePhase Program

The SBIR Program is structured in three phases:

Phase I.The objective of Phase I is to establish the technical merit, feasibility, and dominal proposed R/R&D efforts and to determine the quality of performance of the small business awardee organization prior to providing further Federal support in Phase II. SBIR Phase I awards normally do not exceed \$150,000 total costs & domonths.
